School Dress Code

School Uniform

- All grade and middle school students are required to be in complete Tokyo West International School (TWIS) uniform during the school week, except for special occasions or events.
- All kindergarten students are required to be in uniform when departing the school premises (like park trips every Friday or field trips)
- Students are expected to keep their uniform neat, clean, and tucked in.
- All grade and middle school students must remove outside jackets whilst in class and within the school building, except for during recess and lunch time.
- If students have a P.E. lesson, they are required to wear TWIS P.E. uniform to school.
- All students must change into indoor shoes whilst inside the school building. Students must leave indoor shoes at school and wear outdoor shoes to and from school.
- Ensure to clearly label all of your child's clothes and uniform with their full name and grade.
- The school does not hold any responsibility over lost or damaged items, including school uniforms.

Dress Code Guidelines:

- Students are to wear clothing in the manner it was designed to be worn.
- Students are not to wear clothing that reveals the body in an inappropriate manner.
- All clothes should be in a state of good repair. Clothing with holes, rips, or tears may not be worn.
- The wearing of clothing, insignia, symbols, or adornments worn or carried on or about a student that may promote the use of any controlled substance, including but not limited to drugs, alcohol, or tobacco, is unacceptable.
- The wearing of clothing that features vulgar words, pictures, or drawings, or the sake of humor, includes phrases of a sexual nature or phrases that have derogatory orientation, or disability is unacceptable
